Co-Responder Program Oversight

Tiffani informs all that Adams County Program is running smoothly. McKenzie and Kal are doing well. Katy asks who is the Mobile Crisis Responder. This is through WellSpan. If not able to send out they will send out a Co-Responder. Katy asks when does the delegate decide to utilize Mobile Crisis. Tiffani says they don't. Katy and Tiffani will meet at later date to discuss what can be done at the jail. Katy inquires about data collection. Tiffani has reached out and has not heard back. Will send another email. Neil has yet to receive any data. Dan says Mobile Crisis will not be sent out.

CIT Update

Class will run from 3/31/25 until 4/4/25. There are six (6) signed up for this class. There will be another class in the fall. Dan is working to rebuild class. Looking to replace role playing with VR to simulate scenarios. MOPEC testing will be conducted. Tiffani asking about field visits. Dan confirms that this will take place.

Katy asking how we can take care of the caregivers of the County. Several agree that we need a CISM team that supports all. 988 like effort.

Katy and Neil Meeting Update – handouts distributed

Both reached out to all the agencies and have combined all the information they received. Several agencies supplied updates, and others only outlined their duties as it pertains the intercept map.

Intercept 1

York/Adams Drug and Alcohol Services

Direct Referrals – In York City only, see Wellness Court. Katy asking if there is a way to attract providers that did the direct referrals. Billie says there is not a need since offices have been filled. Hoping to keep them staffed.

Detox – arranged/ medically managed. Neil asking for better explanation as to what “detox” is. Billie explains process of different ways to obtain arrangements for detox of emergent need.

Reduction in community provider availability – there are now 3 providers in AC for outpatient

MH/IDD

Increase in ID waiver slots

Gap: Less community provider availability – waiting list

Mobile Crisis – is it going mobile? Dan says no. – Gap/barrier

Increase in dementia patient identification

Need – cross system training

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Spoke about Gaps outlined in handout.

Lack of education in the community about how police may handle someone in mental health crisis – public education on CIT (Gettysburg Connection – possibly resource to use)
