EX – Exempt : Residents can only be exempted by the County Commissioners. The Criteria is as follows:

1. 65 years of age or over, or under 65 years and physically or mentally disabled, unable to work and verified in a written statement by a physician.
2. Their income must be \$5,000 or less.
