Adams County Adult Correctional Complex:

With recommendation from Acting Warden Katy Hileman, and after review by Solicitor Molly Mudd, Mr. Martin moved, seconded by Mr. Qually, that the Board of Commissioners review to approve the Participating Member Agreement between Adams County, vendor Dynamic Imaging Systems, Inc., and the Pennsylvania Counties Risk Pool ("**PCorp**") for the design, installation and support of the electronic documentation program known as Corretrak for real time electronic tracking and documentation of inmates and detainees held at the Adams County Adult Correctional Complex (ACACC). Receivables include the installation of hardware and licensed software at the ACACC by vendor, and (4) days of employee training. Total cost of the project is to be paid by PCorp, for hardware totaling \$75,570.80, and for software totaling \$12,133.80. The County will be responsible moving forward for any shipping and handling costs associated with the delivery of additional hardware, licensed software, supplies or additional components, and for hardware/software updates and/or upgrades beyond the Warranty Period and for the continuation of Maintenance Services beyond the Warranty Period.
