Unreimbursed Medical Expense Sheet

Rule 1910.16-6c1
For purposes of this subdivision, medical expenses are annual unreimbursed medical expenses in excess of \$250 per person. Medical expenses include insurance co-payments, deductibles and all expenses incurred for reasonably necessary medical services and supplies, including but not limited to surgical, dental, optical services, and orthodontia. Medical expenses do not include cosmetic, chiropractic, psychiatric, psychological or other services unless specifically directed in the order of the court.

Rule 1910.16-6c3
Annual expenses pursuant to this subdivision (c), shall be calculated on a calendar year basis. In the year in which the initial support order is entered, or in any period in which support is being paid that is less than a full year, the $\$ 250$ threshold shall be pro-rated. Documentation of unreimbursed medical expenses that either party seeks to have allocated between the parties shall be provided to the other party no later than March 31 of the year following the calendar year in which the final bill was received by the party seeking allocation. For purposes of the subsequent enforcement, unreimbursed medical bills need not be submitted to the Domestic Relations Section prior to March 31. Allocation of unreimbursed medical expenses for which documentation is not timely provided to the other party shall be within the discretion of the court.
