Erosion & Sedimentation (E&S) Control, E&S Control Permit, and National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Application Package Revised October 24, 2024

ADMINISTRATION:

All permit Notice of Intent (NOI)/applications must include all items required by the NPDES NOI checklist or E&S Control Permit application checklist.

The Adams County Conservation District (District) will review this plan solely to determine whether it is adequate to satisfy the requirements of Title 25 PA Code Chapter 102, the erosion and sediment control and stormwater management regulations of the PA Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP). By a determination that the plan is adequate to meet those requirements, neither the District nor the County assumes any responsibility for the implementation of the plan or the proper construction and operation of the facilities contained in the plan. The design, structural integrity and installation of the best management practices are the responsibility of the landowner and/or contractors. **NOTE:** Before any construction or earthmoving begins, other local, state and/or federal permits may be required from other permitting agencies.

E&S PROJECT FEE SCHEDULE:

This project fee is for plan review and site inspection services for requirements under Chapter 102, Erosion and Sedimentation Control Program. The project fee covers initial plan submission and one re-submission for both completeness and technical reviews unless withdrawn or denied.

WITHDRAWN APPLICATION POLICY:

The following policy has been developed in addition to the current Chapter 102 regulations regarding a withdrawn application:

- 1. Fees submitted with the application will not be refunded. 102.6(c)(3)
- 2. Upon re-application, all fees required by regulation must be submitted. 102.6(b)(1)
- 3. Withdrawn applications that do not change the scope of the project and are submitted within 180 days of withdrawal will be required to pay 25% of the current Erosion & Sedimentation (E&S) Project Fee.102.6(b)(3)

INCORRECT PAYMENT:

All required checks must be complete with the correct amount and payable to the correct name listed on page 3. The District will write void on incorrect check(s) and send them back to the applicant and will contact the applicant for corrected check(s) if check(s) are not complete or correct. The applicant will have 5 business days to get corrected check(s) to the District or all checks will be mailed back to the applicant. The project will not be considered received and will be placed on hold until the corrected check(s) are received.

- Permits that were in effect for 4-5 years will be charged 50% of the District Service Fee for acres left to be disturbed. (Permit Issuance between 12/08/19-12/07/20)
- Permits that were in effect for 3-4 years will be charged 40% of the District Service Fee for acres left to be disturbed. (Permit Issuance between 12/08/20-12/07/21)
- Permits that were in effect for 2-3 years will be charged 30% of the District Service Fee for acres left to be disturbed. (Permit Issuance between 12/08/21-12/07/22)
- Permits that were in effect for 1-2 years will be charged 20% of the District Service Fee for acres left to be disturbed. (Permit Issuance between 12/08/22-12/07/23)
- Permits that were in effect for 0-1 years will be charged 10% of the District Service Fee for acres left to be disturbed. (Permit Issuance between 12/08/23-12/07/24)
