A.	Testing per lot: This fee entitles the applicant to test pit analysis and the preparation of the documents associated With the examination of the test pits (minimum 3).	\$190.00
B.	Testing per probe for spray irrigation systems (Min. 6 per area).	\$ 60.00 ea.
III. Percolation Test per lot (maximum 6 holes). This fee entitles the applicant to the preparation and completion of one percolation test or up to eight holes and the preparation of the forms associated with the performance of the percolation test. If additional percolation tests are required, this fee shall be repeated for each additional test. Holes are to be dug by the applicant in accordance with testing instructions (provided separately)


