Adams County Adult Correctional Complex:

Recommendation by Warden Katy Hileman, and after review by Solicitor Molly Mudd that the Board of Commissioners approve Amendment #3 to the Inmate Telephone Services Agreement with DSI-ITI, Inc. of Falls Church, Virginia (Vendor), whereby Vendor continues to provide domestic, interstate and intra-state phone services to the inmate population; for the provision of a Security Scanner including annual maintenance and support, at no cost to the County; for the installation and use by the inmate population of (115) IP Enabled Tablets + (3) Flex Units with education and/or entertainment content; upgrades to the Lobby Kiosk and installation of a Booking Kiosk to the Intake Department; and the migration of the OMSe Oracle Server to a Microsoft Sequel Server. The term of the Amendment is for four (4) additional years extending from August 19, 2022 through August 19, 2026, and there is no cost to the County, Vendor is paid by commission out of fees charged to the inmate population for services.
