



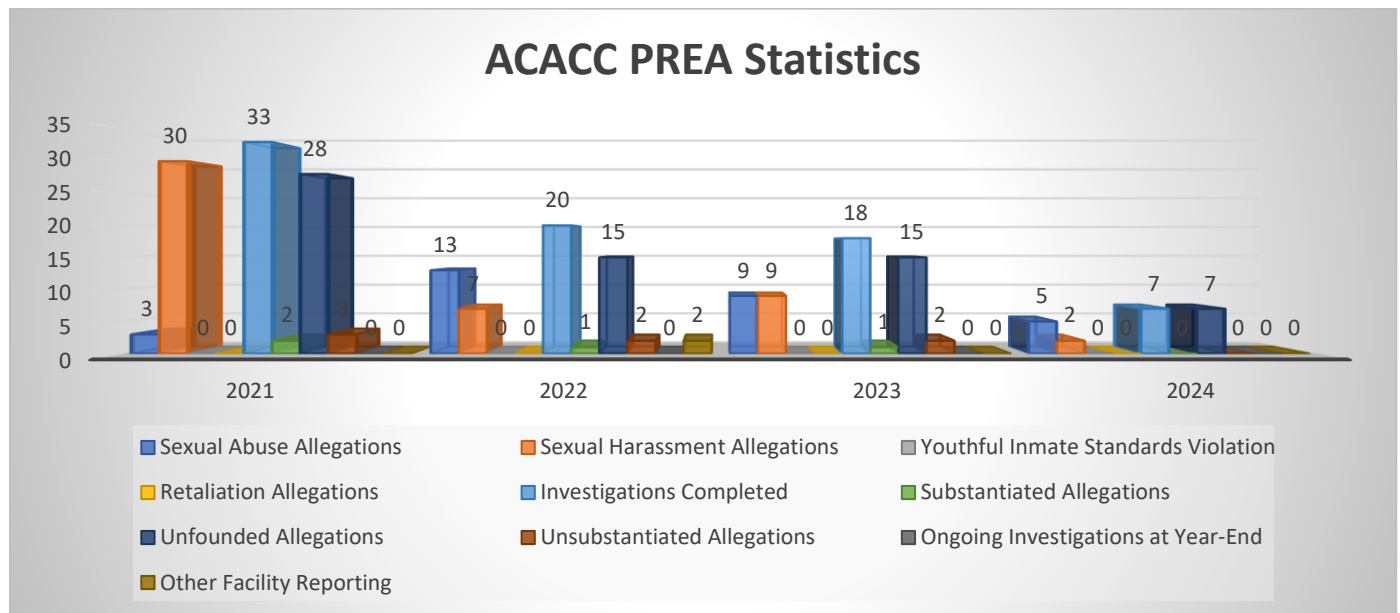

Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Annual Report Calendar Year 2024

Following increasing national awareness of sexual abuse in the nation's prisons and jails, Congress passed the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) in 2003. In 2012, the Department of Justice (DOJ) published the final standards to govern implementation of the purposes of PREA, intended to prevent, detect, and respond to sexual abuse and sexual harassment, through a "zero-tolerance" policy, national standards, data collection, and external auditing.

The Adams County Adult Correctional Complex (ACACC) is dedicated to upholding the goals of PREA by maintaining policies which provide a safe, humane, and secure environment, free from the threat of sexual abuse and sexual harassment for all inmates.

The referenced data in the report below was obtained from the records of investigations maintained by the ACACC PREA Coordinator.
