

# Intercept 0 Community

**York/Adams Drug and Alcohol Services**  
Handles Direct referrals  
Detox  
Warm Hand-offs (G-burg and York)  
Funding and placement for range of treatment needs - OP to LTIP  
Voluntary only

**MHIDD**  
Crisis/On-Call response  
Refer to treatment facility, monitor & follow-up with Law Enforcement  
72 hr. 302 in G-burg and Hanover  
303-305 Commitment hearing

**Children & Youth**  
Can initiate via L.E. or Childline  
Child Abuse Investigations referrals to L.E., MHIDD or YADAC

**First Responders/EMS**  
**Adams Co. Emergency Services 911 Dispatch**

**Crisis Intervention Team**  
44 local Officers avail.  
Situational Eval. of MH needs  
Engage Mobile Crisis  
Refer to YADAC/ MHIDD  
Provide Clean Diversion from CJS

**Local Law Enforcement**  
#( ) Municipal PDs  
**PSP & DCNR**  
Comm. Resource Referrals or Charged

# Intercept 2 Initial Detention and Court

**MDJs/ Central Court**  
Def. access to D&A Assmt-officers report critical to BH outcome or assistance  
initial DA/PD interaction on Negotiable Facts to impact outcome

**Victim Witness**  
victim advocacy , support and direct BH referrals  
coverage for parent, victim or child services via Victim's Comp  
Services include DTR, KCIT, TIR, advocacy, Dom.Vio notifications

**District Atty**  
on-call  
To charge or not to charge and with what? Custody or no?  
BH can impact negotiations & custody & diversions  
Competency?

**Public Defender**  
must apply  
Initially providing guidance charge specific  
Recommends Services- not direct referral & no follow-up  
Competency?

**Central Booking Center at ACACC**  
Book & Release to Community or Detain and set bail - up to 8 hr process - can result in referral to level screen services  
MDJ responses - 3xs per day - weekend 2xs daily -

**Juvenile Probation Services**  
Allegation rec'd - Detention assmt completed (PADRAI) and child placed in shelter, detention or returned to community in parental/guardian custody  
no referrals or services at this stage

# Intercept 3 Jails/Courts

**Adams County Court of Common Pleas**  
- Arraignment  
- Plea / open or closed  
- Sentence - can be statutorily driven - PSI - Court considerations begin with nature & severity of offense, prior record, risk to community, sentencing guidelines, mitigating behavioral health needs to consider introduced via PD- agreed to by DA

**PTSD** - evaluated by court - defense atty driven and if active with the VA-plan of programming - comm.w/ probation

**Pre-sentence Diversions-recommended by DA/ approved by Court**  
ARD, ADP, DV w/ Novis

**ACACC / Jail Pre-Trial Detention**  
Denials for medical reason sent to ER to clear  
Complete Intake of BH needs to determine jail services of: Psych Nurse ,Tele Psych, MH Group  
Edu. Treatment programs:w/ required post sentence - Levels 1-3 of active MH watch - req. transition assist  
IOP - program (12)  
SO Control group

**DPS/Adult Probation Services**  
Risk/Needs Assessment /CRN , PSI  
Pre-trial supervision  
IP consideration Evaluation (D&A)  
Sentenced Probation Supervision  
Referral services  
Comm. Service

**Sex Offenders** - registration - statutory requirements - victim response - intensive supervision - V/W gets case - CAC also - SANE nurses at hospital

**A.C. Juvenile Court**  
Staffing w/ DA  
condition based BH directives - intake assmt/YLS - Psych evals  
family service referrals  
T4C -Ang. Mgt- JUMP - MHIDD

# Intercept 4 Re-entry - criteria

**Forensic Mental Health Partnership**  
requires- Axis 1diagnosis  
PA resident 6 mos. prior full psych assmt.  
behavioral needs  
voluntary participation  
court ordered - 5 stages

**DOC / Prison**  
SO programming - SO classification setting

**ACCAC - Jail Sentence**  
no transition planning for provider connection  
similar transition on Psychiatric planning levels - see Int 2-

**DPS Re-entry Program**  
IP or PC sentences-  
Pre-Commit process for IP  
PC - def. applies to go to re-entry must meet classification criteria  
- those with Inpatient Txt. rec. denied - txt requit coord. via POs if accessible in the community  
NO internal behavioral programming  
Can be in RE to attend Txt, work, CS, medical appt. ,  
self transport or local transportation provided during specific hours

**Contracted Juvenile Placement Facility**  
Factors = comm. safety, severity of offense and risk/needs  
3 levels  
Shelter- up to 30 days  
Community Residential Detention

# Intercept 5 Community Corrections

**State Parole**  
PBPP Comm. supervision

**Revocations**  
- return before the court when someone on community supervision P/P has committed a severe enough violation of their supervision rules and conditions  
- graduated sanctions  
-return to Int 3

**Parole/ Release Transition**  
-home plan investigation  
-treatment continuity planning  
-parole petition w/input from Warden, DA, & jail treatment staff  
-parole granted or denied by court  
-supervision transition to community PO at a level determined via LSCMI- unless EM/HA transition for IP

**Probation Services**  
- community supervision period determined by sentence term  
- restorative justice model  
- level of supervision designated via LSCMI score  
-range from intensive to administrative  
-case plan established focused on top 3 RNR as identified in assmt. and sentencing conditions  
-MH/ D&A treatment/counseling referrals as needed  
-all have community service req.  
-accountability w/response
