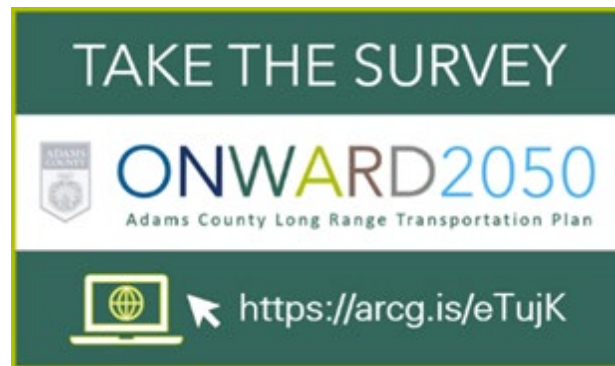

FINAL TRANSPORTATION REVENUE OPTIONS COMMISSION (TROC) REPORT

The Transportation Revenue Options Commission submitted its final report to Governor Tom Wolf on Friday, July 30, 2021. In 2019, the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) identified major risks to transportation funding such as reduced fuel revenues, unpredictable federal funding, and legislative changes to reduce commitments. **This strategic funding proposal aims to address the acute transportation funding challenge**
