TITLE: Traffic Control 101

DESCRIPTION: This course takes the student, regardless of their involvement in traffic control

operations, through all that they need to know at the technician level. The class is designed for firefighters, EMS, municipal workers, police officers, and fire Police. Managers will also attain valuable information regarding all of the responsibilities entailed in the task – it's not just "waving your arms" and setting out some cones! A 16-hour class, the student will receive a very thorough overview and several sections will be presented in-depth. The student will be able to:

- Discuss the need for traffic control
- Identify the legal aspects of traffic control
- Identify attire and equipment requirements
- List methods of activation and control
- Identify traffic control devices and describe proper use of each
- Demonstrate point-shoulder traffic control
- Demonstrate various methods of advanced warning, including proper placement
- Demonstrate how to set up TCPs variations for operating traffic signals
- Demonstrate detour placement and signage
- Demonstrate proper control of traffic queues
