  - a) Adams Co. Commissioners:
    - i. Commissioners have 5 initiatives and Broadband is one of them.
    - Update re America 250. A Steering Committee has been formed and met with 25 members of the larger organizations in the County. Steve \_\_\_\_\_ (from the County) is liaison and planning department is involved)
    - iii. (Randy gave dates reelections but I didn't get everything) Primary is May 17.
    - iv. Approved County Treasurer to collect taxes for Adamstown and Arendtsville. Chris Redding agreed due to shortage of tax collectors.
